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Introduction

This policy relates to the process regarding educating students outside of their chronological year group. This relates to a request received for a child to be educated outside of their normal age range year group; that is that they are educated in the year group below, or the year group above, of their chronological age. This policy applies to all schools in the MAT.

This policy does not relate to situations where students are in mixed-age classes. Mixed-age classes are where students may be taught in a class where a number, or even the majority, of students are in an adjacent year group. As long as this arrangement will not affect the age at which the students will transfer to the next key stage in their education, then the student is not considered to be 'educated outside of his/her age group'.
