Under its Funding Agreement, the Trust is required to comply with sections 450-457 and 459Section 457 of the Act requires schools to determine a policy setting out the circumstances in which the school will charge for certain activities, and the remissions which are available for those charges. In accordance with the Act, the Trust will not pass on charges to eligible parents where the charge is for board and lodging on residential visits which either take place during (or mainly during) school hours, or are provided as part of the national curriculum, the syllabus for a prescribed examination or statutory religious education.

For the avoidance of doubt, statutory remission is available for the cost of board and lodging for visits which take place outside (or mainly outside) school hours.
